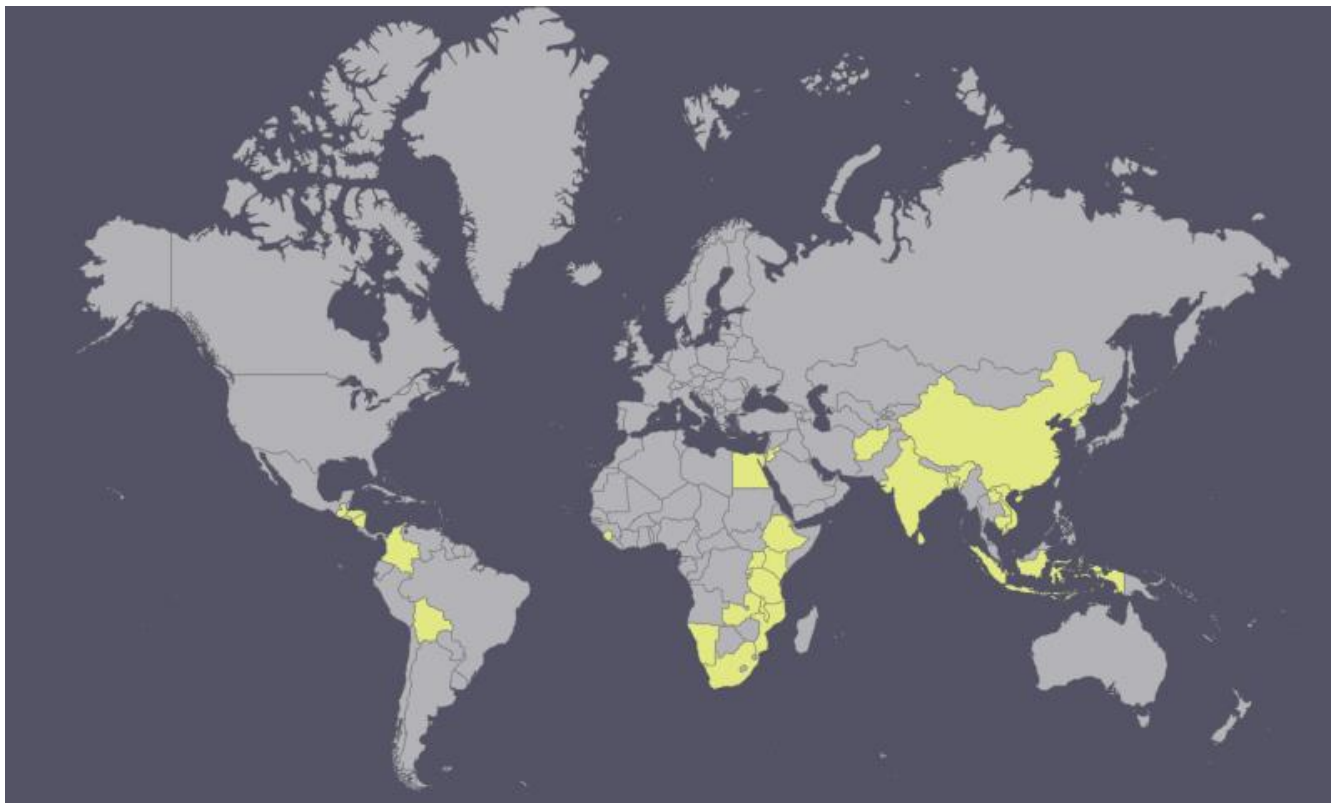

- Child protection – reduce violence through CRC



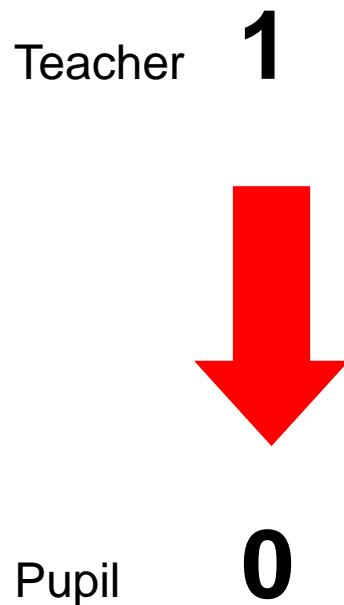


Change Agents in Bangkok 2012 – global network
